New Precision Ag Service—PA Gateway

In our previous newsletter we mentioned our new precision agronomy service **PA Gateway** which will incorporate several new services and technologies.

Yield Map Data Processing Service

Our yield map data processing service is up and running with processed data being provided back to clients within approx. 4 -5 business days. Now is the time to ensure your yield map data is not lost; yield map information is extremely valuable and processing ensures the data is not lost, the maps are able to be used for variable rate (VR) applications and ensures for more accurate ground truthing of problem areas.

Soil Survey Vehicle—EM & Radiometrics

We are about to commence surveying with our new soil survey vehicle, which will deliver Dual Electromagnetic (EM) and Gamma Radiometrics mapping of your paddocks. We believe this will be the first service of its kind in the Eastern states of Australia and feel it presents many opportunities for growers to improve productivity.

- **EM** measures changes in soil salinity, texture and moisture content.
- Gamma **Radiometrics** measures changes in the radioactive emissions of Potassium, Thorium and Uranium isotopes which relates to soil properties including gravel, pH and Colwell K.

Together this data can be used to manage variances in soil properties and limitations within a paddock or over a farm. These layers will also stay stable over time therefore collection of data is required only once, unless you undertake radical changes to a paddocks profile ie: ripping and spading.

Some outcomes from survey work may include:

- **Ameliorating soil constraints** to improve production
- Variably apply **lime** based on soil pH
- Variably apply **gypsum** based on soil type
- Soil type and depth to clay maps to aid clay **spreading, delving, deep ripping**
- Surface **drainage** projects
- **Phosphorus** and other nutrient replacement utilising yield maps and EM data
- **Variable rate** application rather than blanket rates can be used to target high yield potential areas with more inputs and limit inputs into areas of low yield potential, to save on overall fertiliser costs and increase gross margins.
